QUALITY OF EDUCATION IS INFERIOR:



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Myth

Many believe that the quality of education in foreign medical universities is not up to par with domestic institutions.

Fact

Numerous international medical schools, especially in countries like Russia, Kyrgyzstan, and Uzbekistan, offer high-quality education that meets global standards. These universities often follow a curriculum that is recognized by international bodies like the WHO and comply with NMC norms.

LÂNGUAGE BARRIER IS A MAJOR ISSUE:





Students fear that not knowing the local language will be a significant barrier to their education.

Fact


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NO ENTRANCE EXAM REQUIRED MEANSLOWER STANDARDS:

Myth


It's thought that only students who can't get into domestic medical colleges choose to study abroad.
