NMC's New Rule (Post-2021)

The National Medical Commission (NMC) has made it mandatory for Indian students studying MBBS abroad to:

Obtain a medical license from the country of study.

This applies to all students enrolled after 2021.

Failing to do so makes them ineligible to practice in India



What This Means for Indian Students?

It is a major eligibility criterion to return and practice in India.

 After completing the MBBS degree abroad, students must pass the local licensing exam.

Without which, students cannot get an Indian medical license.
