 license afer completion of
 MBBS Degree, Indian
 students will not be eligible to
 practice in India.
- This Ensures compliance with Indian regulations for overseas medical graduates.
- Essential for a smooth transition to medical practice in India after completing MBBS in Nepal.



Purpose of NMCLE

 A licensure exam required by the Nepal Medical Council (NMC)

 Mandatory for all MBBS, MD, and MS graduates to practice in Nepal

Frequency of the Examination

Eligibility Criteria

Conducted every 4 months

- MBBS Degree: Must be from an Nepal Medical Council recognized medical college
- Internship: 6-month rotatory internship at an Nepal Medical Council approved medical center
